### **Reception Admissions 2018**

The online portal for parents to apply for their child's place in Reception next year is now open. Please be aware that transfer from Nursery to Reception is not automatic and you need to apply for your child's Reception place. The portal closes on 15 January and any applications made after this date are classed as late applications and may affect your choice of school. Please make your application as soon as possible.
