Welcome to our first newsletter of the school year. We hope you have had a lovely Summer break and are raring to go!

SCHOOL UNIFORM/BELONGINGS

Please could you make sure that ALL your child's items of school uniform are clearly marked with his/her name. Sensible black (preferably) school shoes/sandals should be worn, trainers are suitable for outdoor PE activities ONLY. Jelly shoes, crocs, sandals/ shoes with heels etc. are great for holidays but NOT for school and often result in twisted ankles, knees etc. Extreme haircuts such as 'strings/ beaded braids', steps, tram-lines, dyes, coloured streaks, tips, tints and fringes inhibiting clear vision are not acceptable. This applies equally to boys and girls. (Long hair must be tied back during PE, games and practical lessons.) St Aidan's has a NO JEWEL-LERY policy. This includes earrings which MUST NOT be worn.

Due to space restrictions your child only needs to bring a small bag to school on a daily basis, school book bags are an ideal size. Please ensure that you child does not attach key rings and mini-toys etc. to their bags, as these often take up space and also cause upset when they become detached and get lost.

Your child does not need to bring along pencils, pens, pencil cases etc. as these are all available in school.

In addition to his/her school uniform and coat the only belongings your child needs to bring are a PE kit which can be kept at school and taken home to be washed on a regular basis.

A <u>simple plain</u> water bottle is also recommended and can be brought in on a daily basis filled with clean fresh plain **WATER** ONLY.

SCHOOL PARKING

We continue to work with Northumberland County Council to implement a

safe traffic management system outside of school. Please think carefully about where to park with consideration for our neighbours. Many of whom have difficulty walking and require access outside of their homes at all times. Walking to school is healthy and environmentally friendly. Please if you can, walk to school or at least park safely some distance away. Please also note that parent / carers are not allowed to use the staff car park unless they have permission from the Governors.

Until the pavement outside of school is widened we strongly advise parent/carers not to use it. Entry to Nursery is <u>NOT</u> permitted through the front car park. Everyone must use the designated walkway from the side main entrance. If you cross this car park you are putting yourself and child at serious risk as cars enter and exit this point throughout the day.

ENTRANCE TO SCHOOL

In the event of heavy rain in the mornings, pupils can come into school from 8.40am onwards. Pupils should come onto the school playground as usual and a member of staff will direct the children to the KS1 cloakroom doors. Nursery parents can access the Nursery entrance.

HOLIDAYS IN TERM TIME

Head teachers are no longer allowed to grant Leave of Absence for the purpose of a family holiday during term time. Absence from school will only be granted in exceptional circumstances and at the discretion of the Head teacher. Parents must apply for Leave of Absence and have this authorised prior to taking their child out of

school, leave will not be authorised retrospectively. Any absence taken without authorisation will be picked up by our Educational Welfare Officer and a fine may be issued. Exceptional Leave of Absence forms" are available from the school office and as much evidence needs to be included to support your application. Please apply at least <u>6 weeks</u> before the leave is required.

PUNCTUALITY

Just a reminder that children should be on the school playground no later than 8.50 a.m. so that everyone is safely in school and ready to begin learning at 9.00 a.m.

HEALTHY SCHOOL

It is important that we work together to encourage your child to make healthy choices. Children are encouraged to bring a water bottle into school—this should only be filled with water—he/she should take it home every day to be cleaned. Pupils in EYFS & KS1 have access to a piece of fruit daily from the National Lottery Scheme. KS2 pupils may bring in a piece of fruit for morning snack—no sweets or biscuits etc.

If you wish to celebrate your child's birthday with his/her classmates please <u>DO NOT</u> send a big birthday cake into school. It is much easier for us if you send in small individual cakes or something similar which can be distributed easily at the end of the day. Many thanks.
