School Lunches


It is very important to let the school office know if you want to swop your child's lunch option.

Supervision of Children

Can we ask parents/carers especially at the end of the school day to supervise your children closely to ensure that they do not wander away while parent / carers are in conversation. The road outside school particularly in an afternoon is dangerous with parked buses

School Arrivals

Please do everything you can to ensure that your child arrives to school on time. It is unsettling for your child to arrive into his/her classroom late and it is important to get them into good habits for later life. If there is anything we can do to help your child's punctuality to improve then please do not hesitate to ask. Please also remember if you arrive and the school playground is empty that you must accompany your child to the main school entrance.

Parking

Could we please ask that parent/carers park safely and legally AT ALL TIMES. Many thanks for your co-operation. Another reminder that anyone parking in the restricted areas around school will be given an immediate fixed penalty of £70. Please also note that parent / Carers are not allowed to use the staff car park unless they have permission from the Governors.

Illness

If your child is suffering from sickness or has diarrhoea, <u>it</u> <u>must be 48hrs</u> from the last bout of illness before they return to school.

Winter Weather

Another reminder to please make sure that your child comes to school with suitable outdoor clothing. A warm, waterproof long coat with a hood, not forgetting hats, scarves and gloves all keep out the rain and the cold. Boots or wellies are a great idea with shoes to change into for inside.

Any pupil arriving when the Reception classroom door is closed/the main playground is empty - should report to the Main Reception entrance accompanied by a parent/carer. In the event of severe weather i.e. Heavy snow or seriously icy conditions and it is necessary to close the school an announcement will be made on BBC Radio Newcastle and posted on Northumberland County Council website.
