#### Safeguarding

Keeping your child safe is our ultimate priority. Can we please remind parent/carers if within the school environment that photographs must ONLY be taken when you have been given permission to take a photograph of your own child. It is then your responsibility to keep that image safe. Sharing images of your child online, especially if you name the school he/she attends could put your child at risk, as he/she could be contacted on line or outside of school.

The Northumberland E-Safety team have asked us to share the following information:

We have received two reports recently of police investigations into the misuse of social networking platforms, specifically children being persuaded to 'friend' and interact with individuals who then

act inappropriately towards them.

It is therefore essential that parent/carers closely monitor their children's internet activities, in particular their use of the latest apps, websites and games.

Just a reminder that we in line with DFE guidance we have recently updated our Pupil Medical Conditions Policy. (All statutory policies can be found on the school website) All documentation has been revised. If your child takes regular medication school must have a completed updated form on record. School staff can only administer prescribed medicines and wherever possible we politely request that medicines are administered at home before or after school.



#### **Parking**

Could we please ask that parent/carers park safely and legally AT ALL TIMES. Many thanks for your co-operation. Anyone parking in the restricted areas around school will be given an immediate fixed penalty of £70. Please also note that parent / carers are not allowed to use the staff car park unless they have permission from the Governors.

We have been asked by Northumbria Police to highlight the fact that the back street behind Newbiggin Road, along from the shop (road sign above) is for residents' parking only and parents are politely asked not to park there. Please work with us and the Police to ensure safe parking outside our school, and report any issues or worries to us immediately.
